Hello Y.B.C. Athletes and Parents

We are happy to announce that the Saskatchewan Youth Bowling School is back for 2024! Youth will enjoy specific instruction meant to advance their current skill set, as well as have an opportunity to work closely with a group of great coaches and mentors who are active and current in our bowling community. Athletes work within a group of peers and receive instruction on a ratio of 1 instructor to every 3 or 4 athletes.

Our school is set up to offer the following options:

Day School – Saturday August 17 (to be held at Nortown Bowling Lanes)

- Open to all ages that can bowl one handed;
- Operates from approximately 9:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.;
- Supper is provided;
- Cost: \$160.00/athlete.

Four Day School – Thursday August 15 through Sunday August 18 (to be held at Glencairn Bolodrome, Golden Mile Bowling Lanes and Nortown Bowling Lanes)

- Open to youth athletes between the ages of 12 and 19 as of December 31, 2024;
- Accommodation for overnight stays are provided by The Atlas Hotel (4177 Albert Street, Regina)
 - o Accommodation cost included in the package
 - o Meals included in the package
 - o Instruction included in the package
 - o Transportation between hotel and lanes included in the package
- Cost \$450.00 (with hotel)
- Cost \$420.00 (without hotel)
