- Certifications of the lanes will change to wood lanes being certified every 2 years and Synthetic lanes every 3 years. Lanes must be certified with working foul lines for any record scores to count.
- Virtual evaluation can be done for coaching (competitive) old level 2.
- IP Nationals in Thunder Bay have sent me the package to be filled in for the winners of this weekend tournament
- Youth challenge nationals in Winnipeg are at Rossmere lanes
- Open Nationals in Edmonton are at Bonnie Doon Lanes
- All coaches must have Comp intro 30 days before Provincial level
- Annette Bruneau is looking for people to help create hosting manual if anyone interested let me know
- Looking forward to a lot of discussion in this meeting and all going forward. Hoping to see some changes for the better and the more people we can get involved the better our executive can be. If anyone is interested please send in writing to myself what you would be willing to learn.

- 6. Please send only 1 set of scores per centre/city.

When e-mailing a photo of the page please make sure the words are in black ink. Sometimes I get them and they are too light and hard to read.

We will also need plaque sponsors. If you or your Association would like to sponsor a division please let me know as soon as you can.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT SASKATCHEWAN 5 PIN BOWLER'S ASSOCIATION SEMI-ANNUAL MEETING February 17th, 2023

Thank you for inviting me to attend your meeting. I appreciate Jennifer taking over for Shona on very short notice and doing her best to ensure the S5PBA is operating in an efficient manner.

Federation: We held our AGM in October. Shirley Bird was re-elected President. We will receive a 3% increase in funding for the 23/24 fiscal year.

The Federation will meet April 30th to approve grant allocations and budget for the 24/25 fiscal year and update our strategic plan.

Map Grant Funding: Map Grant Follow Up Reports and invoices/receipts are due no later than May 15th, 2023. Those who do not comply will be put on probation for the 23/24 fiscal year and will not receive grant funding until the Follow Up Report and invoices/receipts are submitted.

Proposal to change application and follow up deadlines will be presented at the Federation meeting. Changes to the deadline for Applications is from November 1st, 2023 to October 15th, 2023 and Follow Up submission deadline from May 15th, 2024 to April 30th, 2024.

A reminder those who submit both their application and follow up reports on time are eligible for surplus funding. There has been surplus funding every year for over a decade.

Award Pins: I have only received two orders this year for award pins from local associations. It is my understanding C5PBA is no longer requiring trading of provincial pins at National Championships. I'm looking for feedback on the viability of this program.

Police Checks: A reminder police checks are valid for 5 years along with a Reporting of Criminal Charges form submitted to the Federation office via email. Please scan and email the police checks and RCC forms. Fax is not available.

Sponsors: Great Western is accepting receipts for product purchased and rebates will be resumed. Please submit your receipts to me at the Federation office or at your AGM this September. The AGM will be the cut off for submission of receipts. James Mueller, our Great Western Representative asked for more promotion of **Great Western Product** at the local and zone level. Ads were sent out to everyone in order to facilitate this. How is that going?

Grant funding is a benefit of affiliation with **Sask Sport Inc.** and its funding agency **Sask Lotteries**. Please promote the benefits you receive and purchase tickets.

Exceptional Needs: There is grant funding available for rural communities for programs and services. Should any of you want to apply please contact me. I have one application thus far for this fiscal year.

I would like to thank all of you who volunteer at all levels of our sport. Thank you for your contributions.

MBAS Report for the Sask 5PBA SAGM - February 17, 2023

Master/YBC Provincials were held in Regina at the Nortown and Glencairn on Sunday, February 5th; total of 39 teams partook; 13 teams in each of the Bantam, Junior and Senior Division

We held our 1st and 2nd qualifying tournaments for MBAC Nationals the third weekend in November and our 3rd and 4th qualifying tournaments is scheduled for the third weekend in March in Regina. The Master Nationals are scheduled to be in Nfld.; Opening ceremonies June 29th and bowling June 30 – July 3rd. We will be travelling to Nfld. June 27th and returning July 4th.

Currently the MBAS has 115 members.

We have to date this fiscal year hosted 1 Introduction to Competition Course with four in attendance; another is scheduled for the March10-12 weekend in PA; 3 Community Coach Clinics with twenty-three in attendance with another scheduled to be held on February 26th in PA and we have evaluated 10 Trained Competitive Coaches to become Certified Competitive Coaches. The addition of the online Expression of Interest for a Community Coach Clinic, Introduction to Competition Course and wanting to be evaluated has been a success; so much so that we have not been able to keep up with the interest; most of our Coach Developers are also volunteers in the 5Pin world as well as bowlers so we will hold more clinics and courses as soon as we can. We do not at the time have any Coach Developers that can do a Community Coach virtual clinic but I have gotten ahold of Alberta and they will advise when they next schedule one and we will contact those that are interested.
