RE: 2025 - 2026 NATIONAL YOUTH CHALLENGE COACHES

It is once again time to prepare for the Youth Challenge Tournament. The Provincial Youth Challenge Tournament will be held Sunday, January 11, 2026 in Prince Albert. The top three (3) girls and top three (3) boys, based on total pinfall, will advance to the National Youth Challenge to be held Edmonton, AB March 25 - 28, 2026

In order to prepare the team for the National event, the S5PBA requires one (1) male and one (1) female coach. Both must be fully Competitive Coach Certified a minimum of thirty (30) days prior to the Provincial Championships and be a current C5PBA member in good standing.

Responsibilities will include:

- Pre-competition practices This is an "All Star" team so the location shall be determined after the team is declared.
- On site coaching 6 bowlers - 5 play with 1 substitution allowed (format similar to the Open)
- Team Chaperones provide supervision at all times during the National event.

The selection of a coach is for two (2) years, with a male (even year) and female (odd year) coach being selected on alternate years. The first year is as an assistant coach, the second as head coach.

This year we will be selecting a male coach. If you are interested in applying, please submit a brief resume outlining your previous coaching experience, especially with youth bowlers.
